The Board of Directors of Thruvision Group plc (AIM: THRU, “Thruvision” or “the Group”) (the “Board”), the leading international provider of walk-through security technology, is pleased to announce the appointment of Victoria Balchin, currently Chief Financial Officer, as Chief Executive Officer with effect from 2 January 2025.

Following the departure of Colin Evans in October 2024, working closely with Executive Chairman Tom Black, Victoria has been instrumental in ensuring that the business continues to be managed highly effectively with a view to returning Thruvision to growth in the second half of the financial year.
